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REQUEST

The Mississippi Institutions of Higher Learning (IHL) has requested an updated version of their annual workforce report, which provides summary information on the employment and earnings outcomes of Mississippi public university graduates. This updated report utilized the same measures as the report conducted in the Fiscal Year (FY)¹ 2025. The only change is that the study window has been moved forward by one year.

The following information is included for student cohorts graduating from Mississippi's public universities in academic years (AY)² 2014-2015 through AY 2022-2023:

- The number and percentage employed in Mississippi one, three, and five years after graduation.
- For those employed in Mississippi, the median earnings one, three, and five years after graduation.

This information is provided by degree type (i.e., bachelor, masters, doctoral, professional, and specialist) and by specific program of study, along with breakdowns by race/ethnicity, gender, and residency status.

Carrying forward results from the report conducted in the FY 2025, this year's report adds the following cohorts to each observation window:

- One year after graduation: AY 2022-2023 graduates
- Three years after graduation: AY 2020-2021 graduates
- Five years after graduation: AY 2018-2019 graduates

¹ The Fiscal Year in this report is from July to the following June of next year. For example, FY 2025 covers July 2024-June 2025.

² The Academic Year (AY) in this report is defined as summer, fall, and spring semesters. For example, AY 2014-2015, also called AY 2015, covers Summer 2014, Fall 2014, and Spring 2015.

METHODOLOGY

DATA

Data for this study came from Mississippi's State Longitudinal Data System (SLDS), which includes administrative records from more than 25 state agencies. Data from the following SLDS data contributors were used:

Mississippi Public Universities – Data on 4-year public university graduates are contributed to the SLDS by Mississippi's eight public universities and the Mississippi Institutions of Higher Learning (IHL). These data include information on enrollment, county of residence, academic major, and graduation.

Mississippi Department of Employment Security – Employer wage records are contributed to the SLDS by the Mississippi Department of Employment Security (MDES). Employer wage records are collected from Mississippi employers that participate in the state's covered employment system. These data include information on quarterly earnings, company of employment, industry of employment, and county location of employer.

INDICATORS

The following indicators were constructed:

Mississippi Public University Graduates - The number of university graduates who earned a bachelor's degree or graduate degree from a Mississippi public university between AY 2015 and AY 2023. If a student graduated from more than one university in a given academic year, the student was only counted once in the analysis. Graduates from the following universities were included:

- Alcorn State University
- Delta State University
- Jackson State University
- Mississippi State University
- Mississippi University for Women
- Mississippi Valley State University
- University of Mississippi
- University of Mississippi Medical Center
- University of Southern Mississippi

Graduates Not Reenrolled – The number of Mississippi public university graduates who did not reenroll in a Mississippi public university within one year of graduation.

Employment – For graduates not reenrolling in a Mississippi public university within one year of graduation, the number and percent who were employed by a covered Mississippi employer one, three, and five years after graduation.

Median Annual Earning (MAE) – The median annualized earnings for those employed one, three, and five years after graduation. Wage records in the second quarter at one, three, and five years after graduation were multiplied by four to create the annualized earnings for each observation window, and the median of these earnings are reported.

PRESENTATION OF RESULTS

The results are tabulated for each graduating cohort and broken down by:

- Residency status: In-state residence or out-of-state residence at graduation.
- Race/ethnicity: Non-Hispanic white, non-Hispanic black, Hispanic, or non-Hispanic other race.
- Gender: Male or female.
- Degree type: Bachelor, master, doctoral, professional, or specialist.
- Program of study. Programs of study are categorized by the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) codes, which is used by the U.S. Department of Education as the standard method of classifying academic programs. The only exception is that Nursing is reported separately from the overall Health program of study.

DATA SUPPRESSION

In accordance with SLDS Rules and Regulations, numeric values less than 10 were suppressed along with the accompanying percentages. These suppressed values were replaced with the “<10” symbol, and the accompanying percent was replaced with the “---” symbol.
